NOTIFICATION FOR VIDYAVARIDHI (Ph.D.) 2020-21

Applications in the prescribed proforma are invited from the intending eligible candidates for Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D) programme under various Departments of Shri Jagannath Sanskrit Vishvavidyalaya, Shri Vihar, Puri for the session 2020-21. The details including the eligibility, vacancy position, written test, exemption from written test and cost of application fees etc. are noted below for ready reference of the applicants. Interested eligible candidates are requested to apply in the prescribed proforma available in the University website and submit to the **Chairman, P.G. Council, Shri Jagannath Sanskrit Vishvavidyalaya, Shri Vihar, Puri, PIN - 752003, Odisha** by Regd. Post / Speed Post so as to reach latest by 30/04/2021.

2. Eligibility

- (i) Candidates for admission to the Vidyavaridhi(Ph.D) shall have a Master's Degree in the relevant subject from an Indian University duly recognised by the U.G.C. with at least 55% of marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in UGC-7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale where ever grading system is followed) or an equivalent degree from a foreign educational institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognised or authorised by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its own country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions.
- (ii) A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ ST/ OBC (non-creamy layer)/ differently-abled and other categories of students as per the decision of the U.G.C from time to time, or for those who had

obtained their Master's degree prior to 19th September, 1991. The eligibility marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible based only on the qualifying marks without including the grace marks procedures.

3. Research Eligibility Test (RET) [Written]

(i) Subject to exemption, all the eligible candidates shall have to appear the written test to be conducted at the University campus.

4. Exemption from Research Eligibility Test (RET) [Written]

(i) The candidates qualifying UGC-CSIR-NET (including GRF)/ GATE/ SLET/ Teacher fellow are exempted from **written test only**.
(ii) Vishistacharya (M.Phil) Degree holders are exempted from **written test** provided they have been admitted to Vishistacharya (M.Phil) Programme through ET & I and have studied Research Methodology as one of the papers.

5. Research Eligibility Test (RET) [Interview]

(i) All the applicants have to appear the interview to be conducted by the Vishvavidyalaya in the University campus.

6. Course Work

- (i) For admission to Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D.) programme, the candidate has to undertake Pre-Ph.D. course work conducted by Shri Jagannath Sanskrit Vishvavidyalaya, Puri or any other University/Institution duly recognised by the U.G.C. Further, the successful candidates of Pre-Ph.D. course work shall be eligible for registration to Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D.) in their subjects concerned. Registration in Allied/ Inter-disciplinary subjects other than his/her subject at the master's level will be decided by the subject research Committee. All the applicants have to appear the Course Work to be conducted by the Vishvavidyalaya in the University campus.
(ii) The selected candidates will have to undertake a coursework of one semester (six months) in the discipline concerned.
(iii) The course work shall be conducted in the respective P.G. Teaching Departments of the University.
(iv) On completion of course work, there shall be a written examination to be conducted by Controller of Examinations to assess the performance of the candidates.
(v) The mode of examination for theory papers shall include written examination at the end of the PPC Work. Duration of examination for each theory paper (05 credits) shall be of 3 hours. The candidates shall have to answer 5 questions one from each unit.

- (vii) Research Methodology shall cover areas such as quantitative methods, computer applications, research ethics, and review of published research in the relevant field, training, field work etc.
- (viii) The pass mark of individual paper for the Pre-Ph.D. course work shall be 40% and 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade.
- (ix) Admission to Ph.D. course work does not guarantee the candidates for undertaking Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D.) in Shri Jagannath Sanskrit Vishvavidyalaya with course completion certificate.
- 7. Reservation**
- (i) Reservation policy of the Government of Odisha, as applicable, shall be adhered to.
- 8. Fees**
- (i) Application fees – Rs. 500/- (Five Hundred) only
- (ii) Fees for Research Eligibility Test (RET) [Written] – Rs. 500/- (Five Hundred) only
- (iii) All the applicants are required to deposit application fees or Rs. 500/- (Five Hundred) only. Candidates not coming under exemption from Research Eligibility Test (RET) [Written] are required to deposit - Rs. 1000/- (Rs. 500/- (Application fees) + Rs. 500/- (RET))
- (iv) The fees be deposited in shape of State Bank of India (SBI) Bank Draft drawn in favour of Comptroller of Finance, S.J.S.V, Puri payable at SBI Puri.
- 9.** The admission of eligible candidates into Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D.) programme is subject to availability of seats and final decision of Subject Research Committee (SRC).
