Essential Qualification :

Professor

- A.(i) An eminent scholar with Ph. D. qualification (s) in the concerned/ allied/ relevant discipline and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.
- (ii) A minimum of 10 years of teaching experience at P.G. Level in relevant discipline or specialization in university / college, and/ or experience in research at the University/ National level institutions/ industries, including experience of guiding candidates for research at doctoral level.
- (iii) Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology - mediated teaching learning process.
- (iv) A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS). [To be submitted in separate format (amended) as prescribed under Appendix -III Table-I (Category 1,11, & III) of the UGC (4th Amendment) Regulations 2016 published vide No. F.1-2/2016 (PS/ Amendment), Dt.11.07.2016 .]

OR

- B. An outstanding professional with established reputation in the relevant field, who has made significant contributions to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, to be substantiated by credentials.
- C. A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the graduate and masters Level for the SC / ST / Differently- abled (Physically and visually differently- abled) / Other Backward Classes (OBC) (Non creamy layer) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic records during direct recruitment to teaching positions. The Eligibility marks of 55% of marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible , based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.
- D. Preference shall be given to the candidates having effective teaching ability & knowledge in computer.

Reader.

- i. Good academic record with a Ph. D. Degree in the concerned/ allied/ relevant disciplines.
- ii. Acharya / Master's Degree with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed).
- iii. A minimum of 08 years of experience of teaching at P.G.Level / Honours Level of +3 Course / P.G.Level & Honours Level (+3 Course) taken together in relevant discipline or specialization/ or research in an academic/ research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor/ Lecturer in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution/industry excluding the period of Ph. D. research with evidence of published work and a minimum of 5 publications as books and/or research/policy papers.

- iv. Contribution to educational innovation, design of new curricula and courses, and technology – mediated teaching learning process with evidence of having guided doctoral candidates and research students.
- v. A minimum score as stipulated in the Academic Performance Indicator (API) based Performance Based Appraisal System (PBAS). [To be submitted in separate format (amended) as prescribed under Appendix -III Table-I (Category I, II, & III) of the UGC (4th Amendment) Regulations 2016 published vide No. F.1-2/2016 (PS/ Amendment), Dt.11.07.2016].
- vi. A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the graduate and masters Level for the SC / ST / Differently- abled (Physically and visually differently- abled) / Other Backward Classes (OBC) (Non creamy layer) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic records during direct recruitment to teaching positions. The Eligibility marks of 55% of marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible , based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.
- vii. Preference shall be given to the candidates having effective teaching ability & knowledge in computer.

In case of Professor & Reader the upper age limit is less than 60 Years.

Principal / HOD for Shiksha Shastri

- i. Good academic record having Acharya / Masters Degree in Sanskrit with at least 55% of marks or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed and Shikshya Acharya / M.Ed with at least 55% of marks or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed .
- ii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/ SET for the respective subjects.
- iii. Notwithstanding anything contained in (i) and (ii) candidates, who are, or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree through a process of admission, registration, course work and external evaluation as laid down in the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph. D. - vi. Ten Years teaching Experience out of which at least five years teaching experience in a Secondary Teacher Education Institution.

The upper age limit is less than 60 Years.

Lecturer

- i. Good academic record with at least 55% of marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale where ever grading system is followed) at the Masters degree level in the relevant subject from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University .
- ii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/ SET for the respective subjects.
- iii. Notwithstanding anything contained in (i) and (ii) candidates, who are, or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree through a process of admission, registration, course work and external evaluation as laid down in the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of Ph. D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 and so adopted by the university, shall be exempted from NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Lecturer. NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted. Provided further the award of degree to candidates registered for the M.Phil / Ph.D programme prior to 11.07.2009 shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing ordinances / Bylaws/ Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree and the Ph.D candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/ SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Lecturer in University subject to the fulfillment of following conditions .
 - a. Ph.D degree of the candidate awarded in regular mode only.
 - b. Evaluation of the Ph.D thesis by at least two external Examiners.
 - c. Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D work out of which one must be in a refereed journal.
 - d. Open Ph.D Viva-voce of the candidate had been conducted .
 - e. Candidate has made at least two presentations in Conferences / Seminars, based on his/her Ph.D work .

All these conditions are to be certified by the Vice Chancellor / Pro- Vice Chancellor / Dean (Academic affairs)/ Dean (University instructions) .

- iv. A relaxation of 5% may be provided at the graduate and masters Level for the SC / ST / Differently- abled (Physically and visually differently- abled) / Other Backward Classes (OBC) (Non creamy layer) categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic records during direct recruitment to teaching positions. The Eligibility marks of 55% of marks

(or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible , based on only the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedures.

A relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks to the Ph.D degree holders, who have passed their Master's degree prior to 19th September 1991.

- v. The maximum age limit is 32 years for general candidates and in case of other reserved category of candidates please see the provision under General information . The requisite age (including relaxation) shall be as on 01.11.2017 .

Submission of Application of Forms:

The application form (7 copies) complete in all respects must be sent to the Registrar, Shri Jagannath Sanskrit Vishvavidyalaya, Shri Vihar, Puri, Odisha, Pin-752003 through **Speed Post/Registered Post** only so as to reach on or before the last date of the submission. The application form sent/submitted by any other mode will not be accepted. The application form received after due date will not be entertained.

General Information & Instruction :

1. The Upper age limit (32 years) prescribed is relaxable by 5 years for candidates belonging to the categories of Scheduled Caste (SC) , Scheduled Tribe (ST) , Socially & Educationally Backward Classes (SEBC), Women & Ex-Servicemen, and by 10(ten) years for Physically Handicapped Candidates, whose disability should not be less than 40% .Provided that incase a candidate who comes under more than one category mentioned above, he/she will be eligible for only one age relaxation benefit, which shall be considered most beneficial to him/her .
2. The application form duly filled in by the candidate must be supported by self attested copies of all certificates, mark sheets, evidence of teaching, research experience and production of Ph. D. scholar(s), copies of published articles, certificate containing the record of date of birth. **The required proforma for API as per UGC (4th Amendment) Regulation 2016 is appended herewith .**
3. Candidates are required to attend the interview on their own expenses. Candidates are required to produce their original certificates/testimonials for verification at the time of interview.
4. The pay shall be fixed as per the guidelines prescribed by UGC and Govt. of Odisha .
5. ST/SC/SEBC candidates must furnish the original Caste Certificate issued by the competent authority for verification. Disability Certificate (indicating percentage of disability) of Physically Handicapped candidates issued by the concerned medical board / competent authority shall be submitted with the application.
6. Applications of the in-service (Regular) candidates should be routed through the employer concerned. However, advance copies may be sent directly to save delay subject to the production of no objection certificate at the time of interview.
