The curriculum is designed based on innovative pedagogical approaches for learning materials, assignments, and assessments. The university is implementing the ABC system as prescribed in NEP 2020.

5. Vag Vardhini, conducted for all classes including pedagogy, helps students improve their Sanskrit language skills.

These students are identified based on their performance in university examinations, internal assessments, and evaluations conducted by subject teachers.

At the outset of each course, teachers at Shri Jagannath Sanskrit University assess the students' learning levels and familiarity with the course content. Based on these assessments, tailored programs are devised to cater to the needs of both advanced learners and slow learners. Special remedial and supplementary classes are organized specifically for slow learners to ensure that they achieve parity with their classmates in understanding the syllabus.

Furthermore, even after the completion of the syllabus, revisions are made to provide additional support for slow learners and students who join the course late. This proactive approach aims to foster an inclusive learning environment where every student has the opportunity to thrive academically.
