2.2.1 - The institution assesses the learning levels of the students and organises special Programmes for advanced learners and slow learners

Shri Jagannath Sanskrit University commences each academic year with an array of orientation programs, including Bridge Courses,

Sanskrit Sambhasanah Shibirams, and interactive sessions in collaborated with various institutions (Loka Bhasa Prachara Samiti) to warmly welcome and acclimatize new students. After carefully assessing and categorizing students into two groups, those with different learning paces, the university offers tailored activities and support to enhance their educational experience.

For students identified as slow learners, the university provides the following initiatives:

- Remedial Classes: Specialized coaching classes are arranged to help students for catch up and improve their understanding in challenging subjects for them.
- Counseling through Mentors: One-on-one guidance and support from experienced mentors is provided to address personal and academic concerns.
- Peer Learning: Collaborative study groups are formed to encourage mutual learning and knowledge sharing.
- Language Clubs: Opportunities to participate in language clubs to improve linguistic proficiency for Students Identified as advanced learners.
- Group Discussions: Engaging in group discussions to foster critical thinking and communication skills.
- Student Seminars: A platform for students to present and discuss their ideas and research.
- Sastrartha Parishat: Advanced level seminars and discussions on various subjects.
- Seminars and Workshops: Interactive sessions are scoped for students to broaden their horizons and deepen subject knowledge.
- Peer Tutoring: Advanced Learners are provided guidance and assistance by their peers in need.
- Organizing Extension Lectures: Inviting eminent scholars to deliver insightful talks on various subjects.

- 1. Experiential Learning: The University integrates experiential learning into its curriculum through activities such as internships, peer tutoring, comparative analysis, and yoga practice. These practical approaches enrich students' understanding capacity and analytical skills in various subjects, of Acharya (P.G.) and Shiksha Shastri(B.Ed.)
- 2. Comparative Analysis: Comparative analysis is emphasized as a means to achieve a deeper understanding of sastraic learning and other subjects, fostering a critical and analytical approach to knowledge.
- 3. Aesthetic Approach to Literature: The University encourages students to explore literature from an aesthetic perspective, fostering a deep appreciation for literary works.
- 4. Inculcating Moral Ethics: Ethical values are integrated into the curriculum to instill a sense of moral responsibility and ethical conduct in students.
- 5. Kindling Creative Skills: The University promotes creativity among students, fostering an environment where creative thinking and problem-solving are encouraged.
- 6. Participative Learning: Various activities such as quizes, student seminars, group discussions, shloka rachana (verse composition), and antyakshari (a word game) are used to promote participative learning in the classroom.

- 7. Learning through Dialogue: Students are encouraged to engage in weekly vakyarthas organized by the Vagvardhini parishad, providing them with a platform for intellectual discussions and debates.
