Applications are invited from eligible candidates as per UGC eligibility criteria (UGC Notification dated 18th July 2018 and subsequent amendments) to fill up various regular faculty positions, including backlog vacancies, in the Post Graduate Departments of Shri Jagannath Sanskrit Vishva Vidyalaya, Puri.

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TERMS AND CONDITIONS

QUALIFICATIONS:-

I. Professor (Pay Level-14 as per 7th CPC)

Eligibility (A or B)

A.

i. An eminent scholar having a Ph.D. degree in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, and published work of high quality, actively engaged in research with evidence of published work with a minimum of 10 research publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals and a total research score of One Hundred Twenty (120) as per the criteria given in Appendix II, Table 2 of the UGC Regulation 2018.

ii. A minimum of ten years of teaching experience in university/college as Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor, and / or research experience at equivalent level at the University/National Level Institutions with evidence of having successfully guided doctoral candidate.

OR

B.

An outstanding professional, having a Ph.D. degree in the relevant/allied/applied disciplines, from any academic institutions (not included in A above) / industry, who has made significant contribution to the knowledge in the concerned/allied/relevant discipline, supported by documentary evidence provided he/she has ten years' experience.

II. Associate Professor (Pay Level-13A as per 7th CPC)

Eligibility

i. A good academic record, with a Ph.D. Degree in the concerned/allied/relevant disciplines.

ii. A Master's Degree in Acharya / M.A. with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale, wherever the grading system is followed).

iii. A minimum of eight years of experience of teaching and/or research in an academic/research position equivalent to that of Assistant Professor in a University, College or Accredited Research Institution/industry with a minimum of seven publications in the peer-reviewed or UGC-listed journals and a total research score of Seventy-five (75) as per the criteria given in Appendix II, Table 2 of the UGC Regulation 2018.

III. Assistant Professor (Pay Level-10 as per 7th CPC)

Eligibility (A or B)

A.

i. A Master's degree in Acharya / M.A. with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.

ii. Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC, or who have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET:

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/By-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions: -

- a) The Ph.D. degree/ Vidya Varidhi of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph.D work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC / ICSSR/ CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar, Controller of Examinations or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such Masters Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC or similar test accredited by the UGC like SLET/SET.

OR

B.

The Ph.D. degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of

the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

Relaxation of Marks:

A relaxation of 5% shall be provided (from 55% to 50%) of the marks to the Ph.D. Degree holders who have obtained their Master Degree prior to 19 September, 1991.

General terms condition for Recruitment of Teaching posts

SERVICE CONDITIONS:

1. The University is governed by the rules and regulations of the Higher Education Department, Govt. Of Odisha and as amended from time to time.
2. Appointment to the posts will be made as per the University Act and Statute. Pay and other allowance as applicable to the faculty members will be admissible as sanctioned by the Government of Odisha from time to time.
3. Minimum Qualifications and selections for direct recruitment as a Professor is as per UGC Regulations Notification No. F.1-2/2017(EC/PS), 18th July 2018 and as amended from time to time.
4. The retirement age and other conditions shall be as per HED, Govt. of Odisha norms. Presently superannuation age is 60 years.
5. Reservation of posts will be according to Govt. of Odisha norms.
6. The selection committee shall be as per UGC notification 18th July, 2018 and the pay structure shall be as approved by Govt. of Odisha.
7. All other conditions shall be mutatis mutandis as per Higher Education Department, Government of Odisha.

General Instructions to the Candidates:

1. Online applications are invited for posts of Professors, Associate Professors, Assistant Professors in various disciplines in the University as per the table below till this advertisement is kept open on the University website (as per closing date mentioned).

Candidates are advised to visit University website from time to time and remain updated.

2. Starting date of online application is **15.05.2026** and the Closing Date of online application is **15.06.2026** midnight.
3. Applications to be submitted online at the HIMS portal (the link will be available on Link: <https://hims.odisha.gov.in/>). The candidate should download the PDF format of the application generated after submitting the application form on the format available on the University website (<https://sjsv.nic.in>) and send the application along with the documents through speed post/ Registered Post so as to reach the university within 14

days from the closing date i.e. 29.06.2026. The envelope containing the application should be superscribed "APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF _____" along with advertisement No and Date.

4. Only matriculation/SSC certificate/ pass certificate issued by the concerned educational board will be considered as proof of date of birth. No other document will be accepted for verification of date of birth.
5. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/SEBC category should submit proper caste certificates as per the guidelines and the certificate format of the Government of Odisha.
6. The candidates applying under PWD Category are required to submit the Disability Certificates issued by the competent authority in the format prescribed by Government of Odisha for this purpose.
7. (a) The period spent by the candidates to acquire M.Phil. And/or Ph.D. degree shall not be considered as research experience.
(b) As per the UGC communication dated 1 March, 2016, a certificate from the employer/ head of the Institutions/University has to be uploaded mentioning that the period of active service spent on pursuing Research Degree, i.e. for acquiring Ph.D. simultaneously without taking any kind of may be counted as teaching experience for the purpose of direct recruitment/promotion to the post of Associate Professor and above.
8. The hard copy of application of such applicants who have applied online before closing date will be accepted if it reaches as per sl.no. 3.
9. Candidates above 60 years will not be eligible to apply.
10. No hard copy will be considered if the applicant fails to submit the online application as per closing date.
11. Exchange of reservation is not permitted.
12. The application fee as applicable to be paid online (non-refundable) as per the bank details as given in the online portal.
13. Candidate applying for more than one post will have to apply separately for each post and pay applicant fee for each post.
14. Applications without applicable fee will be summarily rejected.
15. **Submission of Hard copy Application Form:** As the application is online, the candidate must submit the hard copy of application on the prescribed format published on the website along with the copies of uploaded certificates/documents by the closing date stipulated for submission of hard copies through Regd. Post. / Speed Post to (courier ordinary post/ hand delivery not accepted)

17. Candidates should produce all the self-attested documents as per application form and subsequently placed mentioning the SI no. Against which the document is attached.
18. No TA/DA shall be paid to the candidates for attending the Interview.
19. Eligibility of a candidate and satisfaction of any other short-listing criteria shall be considered as on closing date of submission of online application.
20. Incomplete Application form in any respect/and or not in the prescribed proforma or/and without required documents will not be entertained and will be rejected without assigning any reason and no further correspondence will be entertained in this regard.
21. If more than one application is submitted by the candidate for the same post, only the application submitted later within the last date of submission shall be considered. Application in part is not acceptable.
22. The University reserves the right not to fill up any or some of the vacancies advertised without assigning any reason.
23. In case of any inadvertent mistake in the process of selection, which might be detected at any stage even after the issue of appointment letter, the University reserves the right to modify/withdraw/cancel any communication made to the candidate(s).
24. In case of any dispute/ambiguity that may occur to be called for written Examinations/interview. The University will have the right to restrict the candidates and short list most suitable candidates in the process of selection, the decision of the University will be final and binding. No correspondence in this regard will be entertained.
25. No correspondence will be entertained from candidates (not called for interview) regarding conduct and result of interview and reasons for not being called for interview.
26. Canvassing in any form will be a disqualification.
27. The prescribed qualifications and experience are minimum and the mere possessing the same does not entitle the candidate to be called for written Examination/interview. The University will have the right to restrict the candidates and short list most suitable candidates to be called for written Examination/interview to a reasonable number on the basis of qualifications and experience higher than the minimum prescribed or by any other condition that may deem fit.
28. In cases of any disputes, any suits or legal proceedings against the University, the jurisdiction shall be restricted to the Courts in Puri, Odisha which is the headquarters of the University.
29. The University reserves the right to revise/reschedule/cancel/suspend the advertisement/ recruitment process without assigning any reason. The decision of the University shall be final & binding and no appeal / correspondence shall be entertained.

33. Application without signature will not be considered and rejected without refund of application processing fee.
34. Upload your documents in PDF / image format. Ensure the readability.
35. Upload your photograph in JPEG format with a size of less than 200 kb.
36. While applying the applicant should ensure that he/she fulfils the eligibility and other conditions/norms mentioned above and that the particulars furnished by him/her are correct in all respect. In case it is detected at any stage of recruitment including the joining and continuing in the post that the candidate has furnished incorrect/false information or has suppressed any facts then the appointment / service will be terminated and the candidate will be terminated and the candidate will not be entitled for any relaxation including legal procedure.
37. Candidate signing the undertaking is bound by these clauses.
38. In service, the candidate is required to forward the hard copy through the proper channel or attach the NOC, so as to reach the University as per the last date specified. However, to avoid delay, the candidate may submit an advanced copy of the application, but ensure the application is forwarded through the proper channel before the issue of interview call letter.
39. No request for change of post(s) and update of new information in the application form will be entertained after the last date of application.
40. Any other relaxation and reservation as applicable but not mentioned shall be as per the Govt. of Odisha, as notified from time to time.

How to apply

1. Candidates willing to apply for one or more post are to apply online separately paying processing fee for each application separately.
2. The online application can be filled in multiple sessions.
3. Application shall be received online as per the format. No other format of application or CV should be sent against this advertisement by email or in any other means.
4. Persons employed in Government/Public Sector Enterprise/Autonomous bodies should forward a copy of their application through proper channel or should furnish a No Objection Certificate (NOC) from the competent authority or employer.



5. Upload the soft copy of the documents with the online application as per the instruction.
6. Submit the hardcopy of the applications as per the uploaded format along with the attachment and photograph.

For General and SEBC category Rs.2000/- and for SC, ST, PWD, Women category Rs.1000/- to be paid online as per the bank details given in the online portal.


The Candidates are required to make online payment of the applicable application fee through the HIMs portal using Debit Card/Credit Card/Net Banking facilities and other financial instruments enlisted in the Payment Page/Gateway of the Portal. The fee(s) paid shall neither be refunded under any circumstances nor can be adjusted or held in reserve for any other examination or recruitment.

Brief Information on selection process:

1. The application received by due date will be screened / scrutinized.
2. The list of eligible and ineligible candidate(s) will be displayed on the website.
3. The shortlisted candidate will be called for the interview. A maximum of 15 candidates will be called for an interview for a single post, and for multiple posts, the number of candidates shall be called in the ratio of 1:10 as per the scores secured during scrutiny. (As per UGC Notification 18th July 2018; Table 3A of Appendix-II for Assistant Professor and Table 2 of Appendix-II for Associate Professor and Professor)
4. The Screening / Scrutiny and subsequent selection will be as per the UGC Notification 18th July 2018 and supported by the ACT and Statute of the University.
5. The selection committee composition will be as per UGC Notification 18th July 2018 of the University.
6. The candidate will be judged holistically i.e. cognitive domain (Knowledge in the subjects' domain), Psychomotor domain (experience and skill) and affective domain (received and response to question, confidence etc...) the vision and strength of the candidate to empower the students for developed Odisha and Vikashit Bharat including Aatmanirbhar Bharat will also be judged.
7. If University desires, University may intimate the candidate at the time of interview to come prepare with PPT as per the following:
The ppt should include brief biodata, subject domain strength, practical skill, student empower strategy, use of AI in pedagogy, funded research projects, consultancy

research, potential for national/international collaborations, vision for the university and nation building.

8. Candidates are required to bring with them all relevant original documents. They are required to bring only the downloaded application form from the HIMS portal. No other application or format is acceptable (For Hardcopy).
